2nd Place - "A Million Dreams" by Buttercup Class

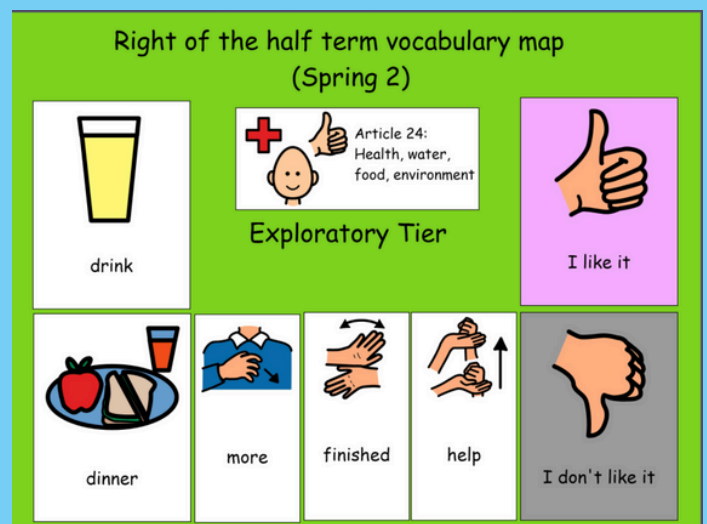
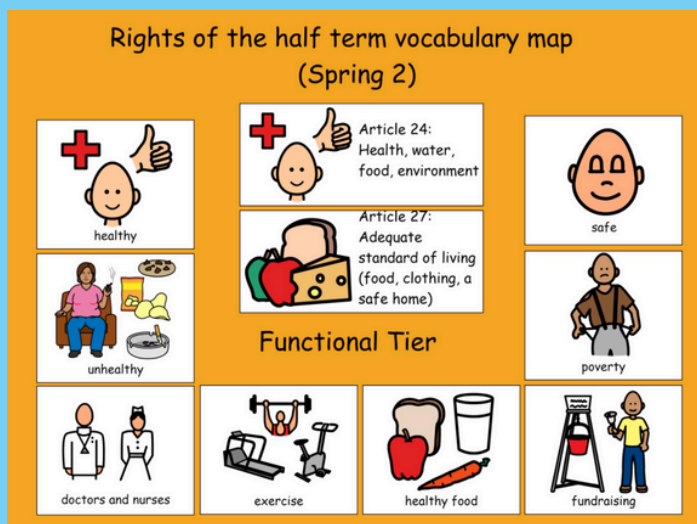
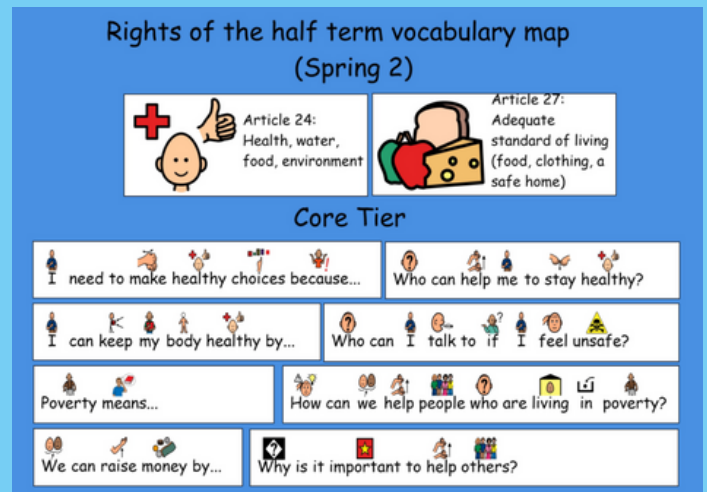
1st Place - "Tulips in Bloom" by Tulip Class
